MEET THE GOLF COACH

LARRY MARTIN is beginning his second year as head golf coach. His first year's team compiled an 8-1 record in dual competition and captured the State University of New York Athletic Conference (SUNYAC) crown.

Coach Martin came to Cortland following a ten year high school teaching career in the North Country — two years at Gouverneur, four years at Massena, and four years at Canton Central where he was director of athletics and coached the varsity football and basketball teams.

A native of Cortland, Mr. Martin received his bachelor and master degrees from the College at Cortland.

1967 VARSITY OUTLOOK

Trying to duplicate the 8-1 record of the 1966 team will be the major job for the 1967 squad. Lost from last year's State University of New York Athletic Conference (SUNYAC) championship team are Duane Rinker, medalist in the State meet in 1966, and Chuck Novak who also won medalist honors in 1965.

Leading this year's aggregation will be juniors Jim Abbot from Whitney Point and Dennis Steier from Binghamton. Jim placed 4th while Dennis was 8th in the 1966 tournament.

Lettermen returning are Mike Gonroff of East Syracuse, Barry Schultz of Carmel, Ed Ozaroski of Huntington and John Wyckoff from Cortland.

Sophomores Steve Loiaconi of Mamaroneck and Pete Siegal from Newburg could break into the top six positions. Joe McKenna, a junior from Brooklyn is returning this year after missing last season because of student teaching obligations.

Competition should be keen for the top six positions this year, and Coach Larry Martin is looking forward to an interesting season.

The Red Dragons will also field a freshman team this year, playing a five match schedule.
