OUTLOOK

Three of last year's top six have graduated and another is studying abroad for a year, meaning that numbers 2-5 must be replaced with new faces. Coach Barney Williams feels that there are too many question marks among his current candidates to flatly predict a lot of success--especially against basically the same strong schedule his charges were up against a year ago. The only slate change finds LeMoyné replacing St. Lawrence (the St. Lawrence match was cancelled by rain last spring).

TENNIS COACH

For the fourteenth year Reuben (Barnie) Williams will guide Cortland's tennis fortunes. Barney came to Cortland from Park College, Missouri, in 1957 and assumed coaching positions in tennis and junior varsity basketball. He later served as head basketball coach for five years. A native of Chambersburg, Pa., Williams graduated in 1947 from West Chester State where he lettered in football, basketball, tennis and track. A former tennis club pro, Barnie is probably still the strongest singles match on campus. He also plays a top game of badminton and squash and was formerly a strong volleyball player.
