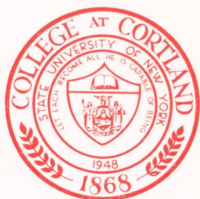

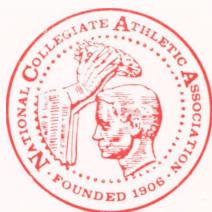

1966-67 OUTLOOK

Two skiers, returning from last year's club squad, will be the nucleus of the 1966-67 varsity. The two veterans are captain Pete Welch of Utica and Bob Vitalius from Rensselaer.

This is the first year that Cortland will field a skiing team as a varsity sport. With this addition, Cortland now has teams competing in fourteen intercollegiate sports.

Head Coach Tom Goodale feels that the team is still in the process of building and it may be awhile before fruits of the team's work are realized. They have a good Alpine team and a Nordic team that is showing vast improvement with each workout.

Much of the team's success will hinge on the development of strength in cross-country and jumping events. At the present time, the jumpers must travel to Syracuse to practice as there are no jumps at the local areas.
