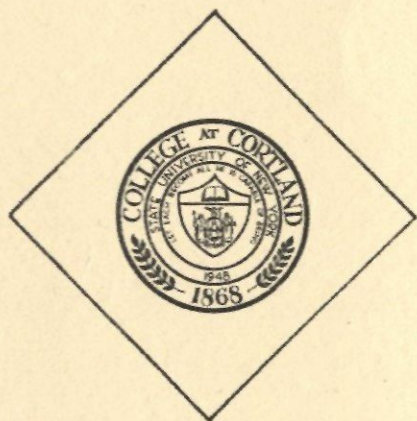

1974-75 OUTLOOK

Only four seniors were lost from last year's team, but the defending state champions only have four more this season. One junior on the roster means 14 first or second year gymnasts for coach Antoinette Tiburzi.

"We're fairly strong," maintains the coach. "But, we need a lot of growth. We have a lot of potential."

She places the cause of her young squad on the vast improvements in public school gymnastics programs. "I like a young team to work with and develop, anyway."

The Binghamton area has produced what could be the nucleus of the bid to improve on last year's 6-3 record (all of the losses to out-of-state-teams). Sophomore Debra Jones of Johnson City has now been joined by a pair of strong freshmen, Jan Seraphim of Vestal and Lynn Spadine of Endicott. Another of the mainstays on this year's squad should be soph Cathy Collins of Rhinebeck.

Ten opponents are on this season's schedule, two from outside the state. Capping the season will be the state meet at Ithaca, Feb. 28-Mar. 1.
