CAROLE MUSHIER

HEAD COACH

Carole Mushier enters her seventh year as the Cortland State field hockey coach. Her objective for the program is participation at the highest level of competition reasonable for the team and within the framework of the College's educational goals for the squad members.

Dr. Mushier is in her first year as women's athletic director at Cortland. She holds a master's degree from Columbia University and a Ph.D. from the University of Southern California. An author of two books on team sports for women, she is past president of the Eastern Association for Intercollegiate Athletics for Women (EAIAW) and a member of the AIAW Executive Board. She was president of the New York State AIAW from 1974 to 1976.

As a player, she was a member of section field hockey teams and played in seven United State Field Hockey Association national tournaments. Dr. Mushier also played on the 1964 women's lacrosse touring team which played in Great Britain and Ireland. She has coached field hockey on the high school, college and association levels.

Field hockey teams coached by Dr. Mushier at Cortland have been in the annual tournament sponsored by NYSIAIW each of the six years the College has competed in the sport at the varsity level. The team finished as State champions in 1973, 1975 and 1976. When not winning the title, Cortland was taking second place the other three years. In 1975, Cortland was invited to compete in the first AIAW Eastern Regional Tournament and was reinvited last year. Dr. Mushier's won-lost record at Cortland is 34-20-8.

1977 FIELD HOCKEY OUTLOOK

The 1976 season was the most successful in the history of Cortland State field hockey and there are high hopes of continued development in 1977.

Cortland plays one of the strongest schedules of any college team in the Northeast District, meeting such powerhouses as Eastern Regional Champion Springfield College and the team that placed third in the National Tournament, Lock Haven State College.

While the Cortland State schedule makes a good won/loss record difficult, it reflects the philosophy of the program and team members to gain the best experience possible and to grow as participants.

With eight of last year's starting varsity squad members not returning this season, the 1977 campaign will depend on the enthusiasm and development of new squad members.

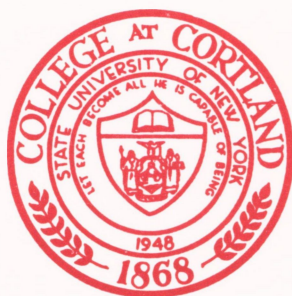
