MEET THE BASEBALL COACH

Bob Wallace is a native of Syracuse, N.Y., and a World War II Navy veteran. He is a 1953 graduate of Cortland. From 1953 to 1956 he taught physical education and coached football, wrestling, volleyball and track at Painted Post (N.Y.) High

wresting, volleyball and track at rainted rost (N.Y.) High School. Each of his teams won county and league championships. In 1956, Coach Wallace returned to Cortland as a member of the Men's Physical Education Department. In addition to his teaching duties at the College, he has coached freshman basketball (1956-57 and 1964-65), varsity basketball (1957-58), assistant varsity football (1956 to present), assistant varsity baseball (1957), and varsity baseball (1958 to present). His teams have have had a losing season.

teams have never had a losing season.

Coach Wallace's varsity baseball coaching record is 95 wins, 35 losses and 1 tie. His teams have won State University of New York Athletic Conference (SUNYAC) championships in 1960, 1961 and 1964. He hopes to have his tenth straight winning season, his 100th varsity win and another conference

championship in 1967.

1967 VARSITY OUTLOOK

Coach Wallace, beginning his tenth year as varsity baseball coach, will have a veteran in almost every position. Returning from last year's team are All-Conference outfielder Rick Page and third baseman Dave Schletter. The lettermen also include: Joe Mushock (All-Conference selection two years ago), Paul Fernandes, Brian Cory, Cal Wheeler, Gary Howe and pitchers Al Greenberg and Joe Chibbaro.

Replacements must be found for Cortland's two-year All-Conference shortstop Marty Minter and pitcher Ken McClenathan. Both men were graduated last June after completing three outstanding years of varsity baseball.

Much of the team's success this year will depend upon the pitching staff. The mound staff is the smallest group that Coach Wallace has worked with since taking over as head coach in

1958. Only five pitchers are on the 1967 roster.

The staff is lead by junior right-hander Al Greenberg of Brooklyn, N.Y., and senior right-hander Joe Chibbaro of Ozone Park, N.Y. The other pitchers, sophomore right-handers Mike Taylor of Auburn, N.Y. and Bruce Burdick of Munnsville, N.Y., and senior right-hander Bob Hildreth of Rhinebeck, N.Y., all

and senior light-hander box finded in a varsity game.
Randy Alexander, a junior from Amsterdam, N.Y., was back-up man for Marty Minter last year, and looks to be his replacement. Although not in Minter's class as a power hitter, Alexander is a stronger fielder and possesses great speed on the base paths. A strong bat to go with his fielding skills could help the Red Dragons attain another winning season.

The Cortland lineup, although not definite as of this writing, shapes up as follows: 1B: Cory; 2B Fernandes or Harry Kost; 3B: Schletter or Kost; SS: Alexander; LF: Mushock; CF: Page; RF Wheeler; and C: Howe or Bob Heintz.
