Biographical History

SUNY Cortland was founded in 1868 as the Cortland Normal school, located in downtown Cortland, NY. The first graduating class was 1871 and included ten students. In the beginning, two ceremonies took place each year, one for spring and one for winter (today there is only one ceremony). In 1919 a fire destroyed the Cortland Normal School building. The Normal School was rebuilt in a new location on top of the hill with the creation of Old Main in 1923 (later changed to the State Teachers College and finally SUNY Cortland). Since then, campus commencement had occurred in multiple locations. These include School Assembly Room (Original Normal School Building), Cortland Opera House, various public facilities, Brown Auditorium in Old Main, athletic fields, Lusk Field House built in 1962, and Park Center built in 1973.

Scope and Content Note

The majority of materials contain photographs and programs. The photographs capture individual students, faculty, posed and ceremonial photographs. Convocation programs date back to the 1950's while commencement programs include the first graduating class to present day. They capture both the spring and winter ceremonies. Diplomas or certificates also exist and include some prominent Cortland figures such as Principle Harry DeWitt DeGroat. There is a small portion of multi-media materials on both commencement and convocation.
