VARSITY COACH

Al Pisano is in his fourth year in the teaching and coaching staff at Cortland. A graduate of Cortland, Pisano has coached football and lacrosse at Berner High School on Long Island. He received his master's from Penn State. While at Penn State, he coached the freshman lacrosse team.

As an undergraduate he was an outstanding lacrosse star, playing four years and being captain for two of them. Pisano was selected to the second team All-American Team on la-

In addition to coaching lacrosse here, Pisano is also assistant coach in football.

ASSISTANT COACH

John O'Connor is also in his fourth year as coach at Cortland. A graduate of Cortland, John received his master's from Albany. He is presently instructor of men's physical education. While at Cortland, John participated in football and la-

crosse.

1967 VARSITY OUTLOOK

This year's squad is fortunate in having several varsity men returning from the 1966 team. The entire 1966 starting attack is back. They include: Harry Blank, a junior from Baldwin, N.Y., Paul Rose, a senior from Baldwinsville, N.Y., and the nation's number one goal-getter in 1966, Rich Felser, a senior from Sachem, N.Y. Behind this experienced trio will be two excellent sophomore prospects from the '66 frosh squad. There are Paul Ruff from Port Washington, N.Y., and Andy Oleski from Yonkers, N.Y.

Returning at the midfield positions will be: 1967 co-captain Al Rhines from Watertown, N.Y., Dick Speckman from Oceanside, N.Y., Al Tepper of Brooklyn, N.Y., Ken Fougnier from Solvay, N.Y., Manny Kazis from Oceanside, and Tom Accentron Shephyrne, N.Y.

According to coach Pisano, the most impressive part of his team thus far has been their defense. "This is the quickest

and best stickhandling defense I have ever coached. I'm certain that they will be tough to beat."

No coach likes to be optimistic early in the season but with the number of experienced players returning along with a fine crop of sophomores, the 1967 varsity lacross team could prove to be Cortland's best ever.
