

1975 CORTLAND STATE BASEBALL

Bob Wallace-Head Coach

Win number 200 is imminent for 18-year head coach Bob Wallace, a feat that will be a first in Red Dragon sports history. No previous coach at Cortland has reached the 200-win mark in a single sport, with the previous high being Prof Holloway's 191 in soccer. Wallace passed that mark with his first victory last fall.

The current Wallace record is 198 wins against only 99 losses and one tie in a career that spans 17 seasons at Cortland. In addition, Wallace's record in SUNYAC conference play is 112-46.

Wallace is a Cortland graduate, and he also earned his M.S. here. Before coming back to his alma mater, Bob coached and taught at Painted Post High School. His duties there included football, volleyball, wrestling and track. At Cortland, he has also coached freshman basketball and football as well as taking over for a year as varsity basketball coach.

JV Coach

Now in his seventh season as Cortland, JV baseball coach Al Stockholm also heads the varsity basketball team. An assistant professor of physical education, Stockholm is a graduate of East Stroudsburg and also earned an M.A. from Maryland. Before his arrival at Cortland, Stockholm was basketball coach at Allegany Community College, Cumberland, Maryland.

1975 Outlook

It will take a stellar spring for Cortland to make a run at the State University of New York Athletic Conference title, but not because the Red Dragons had any major problems in their fall season. Beginning spring play, Cortland is 5-1 in SUNYAC but that single loss will hurt. It was a 6-5 decision to Fredonia which left that team at 9-1 in the conference and most of its schedule completed.

The other SUNYAC contender is Oneonta, also 5-1, and Cortland would need a sweep in its May 3 doubleheader with Oneonta to have a shot at the title. But, there are ten other SUNYAC games to contend with as well and a loss here or there will almost eliminate the Red Dragons.

Making that run at the conference crown is not out of the realm of possibility, as coach Bob Wallace has a solid, strong team

with which to work. The 7-3 fall record was built partly on the strength of a .299 team batting average. Third baseman Bill Izzo led that onslaught with a .429 total. At the other side of the infield is power hitter Bruce Randall. The first baseman hit .387 in the fall but more importantly led the club in three departments. His three doubles, three homers and 13 RBI's were club highs. Even at 5-foot-11, 215, he is part of Cortland's good team speed.

Center fielder Dave Bowman had a .394 fall, leading the team in hits (13). The club boasted two other .300 hitters, one of which was left fielder Craig Johnsen. Hitting .300 even, Johnsen will be on one side of Bowman with Art Cotugno in right. The other .300 batter was Dave Roman with .385. He's currently pushing for a spot at shortstop behindLesh Michniewicz. The other infield spot belongs to Jon Cooley.

The pitching staff will be basically righthanded, except when fourth starter Tom O'Rourke takes the mound. Bill Bartlett and Garth Tymeson are the mainstays,
