Biographical History

The Office of Advisement and transition specializes in accommodating students in selecting courses, transferring from other schools, and succeeded both academically and socially. One major component of this office is to provide advising options for students. They coordinate with advisees and advisors. Additionally, the program “Starfish” was created, and acts as a communication tool designed to help students with academic success. The office coordinates all the classes for COR 101 (Cortland Experience). This is a 1-credit course and was created in 1997 in order to assist incoming students become socially and academically integrated with SUNY Cortland.

Scope and Content Note

The record size is very limited. Contents include proposals, reports, surveys, resources, and textbooks (COR 101) used for and by the Office of Advisement and Transition since the 1950’s to around 2008. This collection is incomplete and is an assortment of subject files.
