## HEAD COACH

RON HANSEN

Ron Hansen, a 1978 Cortland alumnus, begins his first season as Cortland State women's ice hockey coach this year. As an undergraduate, Hansen played one year of varsity hockey at Oswego State and three years on the Cortland State varsity hockey team. During his senior year, Hansen served as a tri-captain for the Dragons.

Hansen, a native of Gravenhurst, Ont., is a graduate student at Cortland State. He also served as assistant coach for the 1978 Cortland State women's varsity soccer team.

## WOMEN'S HOCKEY OUTLOOK FOR 1978-79 SEASON

"Challenging" is the best way to describe the Cortland State women's ice hockey 1978-79 schedule according to Coach Ron Hansen. The Lady Dragons, who finished their first varsity season last year with a commendable 6-4 won-lost record, will play a 13 game schedule against nine private and three state university teams. Highlights of the Cortland season will include games with five new opponents: RPI, Brown, Middlebury, Boston College and Harvard. These additions should help to establish Cortland's young team in the women's ice hockey ranks.

Despite a relatively small squad, Coach Hansen is very optimistic about the 1978-79 season. Of the 15 skaters, 10 are returning veterans from Cortland's first varsity women's ice hockey team last year. Eight of the 10 veterans also participated when women's ice hockey was a club sport at Cortland.

Among the returnees are last year's captain Cindy Corwith of Water Mill, assistant captains Eileen Gregoire of Buffalo and Patty Kelly of Massena, and leading scorer Nancy Owen of Westbury.

Experience will also be provided from newcomers Carol Greenfield, Carol Mehlenbacher and Mary Ann "Mimi" de Wysocki. Greenfield, a freshman from Hamburg, played competitive hockey in the Buffalo area before coming to Cortland. Carol will serve primarily as a center for the Dragons and should bolster the scoring attack. Mehlenbacher and de Wysocki, both freshman from the Ithaca area, were the 1-2 goalie combination for the Ithaca Stars last year. The Stars are an all-star girls traveling team from the Tompkins County Minor Hockey League.

## AN INDIVIDUAL LOOK AT THE CORTLAND SKATERS

BIUNDO, LINDA: A junior from Commack, Linda returns to the Dragons at the right wing position. Linda, who will be playing on a line with Eileen Gregoir and Carol Greenfield, is a good passer and positional player. She also should be one of the leading scorers.

CORWITH, CINDY: Last year's team captain, Cindy returns to anchor down the defense with teammate Ellen Rothenburg. Cindy, a senior from Water Mill, is one of the best skaters of the team and has a strong shot from the blue line. Her experience gained while attending CAN/AM Hockey School in Guelph, Ont., this summer should help.

BEWYSOCKI, MARY ANN: A freshman from Ithaca, Mimi brings knowledge and experience to Cortland's goaltending position. A previous weakspot for the Dragons, goaltending appears to be greatly improved with the addition of deWysocki and Carol Mehlenbacher, both of whom have played with the Ithaca Stars traveling team.

FORTIN, SUE: A junior transfer from Herkimer County Community College, Sue is a novice at the game of ice hockey this year. She will be playing left wing on a line with MaryAnne Gyidik and Laura Lewis that will specialize in defensive situations.

GREENFIELD, CAROL: A freshman from Hamburg, Carol will center a line with Eileen Gregoir and Linda Biundo. Carol, who previously played left wing in a very competitive Buffalo league, has excellent skating and shooting abilities as well as an in-depth knowledge of the game of ice hockey. Her versatility will make Carol a very valuable member of the team this year.

GREGOIRE, EILEEN: A senior from Buffalo, Eileen will play left wing on the Greenfield-Biundo line. Eileen is an experienced player and possesses a fine shot. Eileen played two years of varsity club hockey and served as an assistant captain on Cortland's first women's varsity ice hockey team last year.

OWEN, NANCY: A junior from Westbury, Nancy was the leading scorer on the Cortland women's ice hockey team last year. A versatile player, Nancy will center both the Sullivan-Northrup line and the power play. She also will be used for penalty-killing and as an occasional defenseman. Nancy has played two years of hockey at Cortland as well as in Long Island hockey leagues. This past summer, Nancy attended the CAN/AM Hockey School at Guelph, Ont.

ROTHENBURG, ELLEN: A junior from Cortland, Ellen is a newcomer to Cortland State ice hockey this year. Ellen, who will play defense with Cindy Corwith, has shown much improvement in pre-season workouts and will be a valuable player as she gains experience throughout the season.

SULLIVAN, NORA: A junior from Buffalo, Nora is a returning veteran at the left wing position. This year, Nora will play on the Owen-Northrup line where her offensive and defensive abilities will be a great asset. Nora has a strong shot from the wing and also can deflect the puck.

WAITE, JENNY: A junior from Colton, Jenny will team with Patty Kelly on defense this season. Jenny, who is beginning her third year of Cortland hockey, is a consistent player at the blue line with a strong shot. Jenny also has the ability to lead the attack on break-out plays.



GYIDIK, MARYANNE: Previously a left wing, Maryanne will center the defensive line of Fortin and Lewis this season. A senior from Endwell, Maryanne has played three years of hockey at Cortland and her experience will prove invaluable to the Dragons this year. Maryanne is a good skater and can play both offense and defense positions.

KELLY, PATTY: A senior from Massena, Patty served as an assistant captain for the Cortland women's ice hockey team last year. This year, Patty has moved from center to defense and will be teamed with Jenny Waite on the blue line. Pat is an offensive-minded defenseman who has the ability to score goals. Pat is a former player and coach in the Massena Minor Hockey League and has played three years at Cortland.

LEWIS, LAURA: A senior from Haddonfield, N.J., Laura has three years of hockey experience at Cortland. Laura, who will play right wing on the Gyidik-Fortin line, possess good checking ability and should be a two-way player for the Dragons. This summer, Laura attended the CAN/AM Hockey School at Guelph, Ont.

MEHLENBACHER, CAROL: A freshman from Trumansburg, Carol brings five years of minor hockey experience to Cortland. Carol, who teamed with Mimi deWysocki as goaltenders for the Ithaca Stars traveling team last year, has excellent goalie skills and should help to make goaltending one of the Dragons' strongest positions.

NORTHRUP, BECKY: A junior from Trumansburg, Becky has played two years of Cortland hockey and also has minor hockey experience in the Ithaca leagues. Becky, who will play right wing on the Owen-Sullivan line, is a hard worker and has shown much improvement in pre-season workouts. A good passer and shooter, Becky will be one of the leading scorers on the team this year.

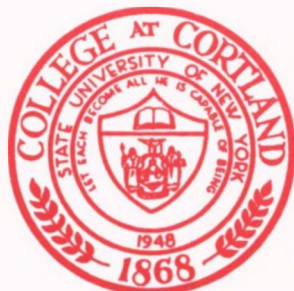
