JOE PIERSON

Head Track Coach

An assistant professor of physical education, Joe Pierson has been head track coach at Contland for seven years. His teams have captured indoor championships in the New York State Track and Field Association Meet five times, and have won the Contland Invitational 3 out of the five meets conducted to date. In competing in the Union Invitational, Pierson's squad has emerged with the championship in three cut of five times, copped two firsts at the Rochester Relays and a first at the Rochester Invitational.

Prior to joining the Cortland faculty, Pierson taught and coached at his alma mater, Southern Illinois University, and at Illinois' Carbondale High School. He also has served as a member of the physical education staff at West Point where he worked in physical education research - concentrating on athletic injuries - in addition to handling the conditioning programs for football and baskatball teams.

While an undergraduate at Southern Illinois, Pierson competed in the long jump and high jump. He earned an M.S. degree from SIU in 1965.

FRED TAUSE

Assistant Coach

Fred Taube has been a member of Cortland's Physical Education Department since 1970 and has been an assistant coach for indcor track since that time. In soccer, he was freshman coach for three years before being named head coach in 1973.

A graduate of SUNY College at Brockport, Taube earned a master's degree in physical education at the University of North Carolina and has a Ph.D. from the University of Utah. Before coming to Cortland, he was at MacMurry College in Jacksonville, Ill., where he coached track and soccer for seven years. He also coached the soccer club while he taught at Auburn University in Alabama from 1960 to 1963.
