## State University of New York College at Cortland

Located atop one of the many hills in Central New York's "City of Seven Valleys," the State University of New York College at Cortland was founded in 1868 as the Cortland Normal School. Over the decades, the campus expanded and in 1941, by an act of the legislature and the Board of Regents, the institution officially became a college, providing four-year courses leading to a bachelor's degree. In 1948, the state legislature incorporated Cortland College into the new State University of New York.

Today, more than 5,400 undergraduate and 600 graduate students are pursuing degrees within the College's two academic divisions — Arts and Sciences and Professional Studies. Twenty-three departments with a faculty of more than 300 offer the Cortland State student body some 40 majors from which to choose, including liberal arts, elementary and secondary education, health and physical education, recreation education, speech education and speech and hearing handicapped education.

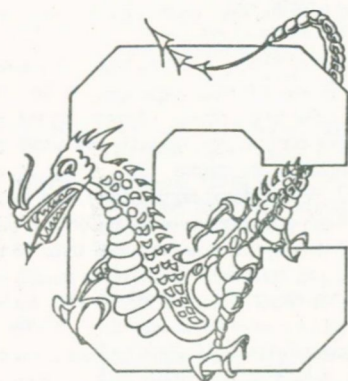
The College's main campus covers 191 acres and includes 30 major buildings. Fourteen of these structures are residence halls and provide on-campus housing for 2,600 students.

At Cortland State, athletics are viewed as having an important role in the educational mission of the College. During the fall, winter and spring seasons, Cortland State participates in 24 intercollegiate sports — 12 men's and 12 women's — in an attempt to provide a broad program of athletics which will meet the needs, interests and abilities of its students.

The stated objective of the College's athletic program is the development and welfare of the student. In the coaching of individual sports as well as in the direction of the overall athletic program, the College endeavors to provide a high calibre of professional leadership which is consistent with the goals of the institution.

Cortland State is particularly proud of its long tradition of intercollegiate athletics and its high standing in small college athletic circles. In support of this heritage, the College offers its student-athletes a number of outstanding indoor and outdoor facilities which are used for intercollegiate competition as well as educational and recreational purposes. The Park Center for Physical Education and Recreation, opened in 1973, features a main gymnasium with a seating capacity of 3,600, an Olympic-size swimming pool with gallery seating for 1,500, and an ice arena which can accommodate 2,500 spectators.

## HEAD COACH PETER CAHILL

A native of Watertown, New York, Pete Cahill grew up in Malone, where he graduated from Franklin Academy prior to attending Cortland State in the mid 1960s. Cahill was a member of the Red Dragon tennis and swimming teams. He swam both the breaststroke and butterfly, while captaining the C-State swimmers during his senior year.

After earning his bachelor's degree from Cortland State in 1966, Cahill went on to the University of Massachusetts at Amherst where he received a master's degree in exercise physiology. He later earned a doctorate in physical education from Springfield College. Cahill taught physical education for two years at Clarkstown High School in New City, N.Y., before taking over as head swimming and tennis coach at Plattsburgh State. While there, he coached four All-Americans in two seasons.

Cahill returned to his alma mater in the autumn of 1972. He immediately began a steady turnaround of the Red Dragon men's program. From a last place conference finish in his initial campaign at Cortland, Cahill and his Red Dragon units consistently moved up the league standings. Cortland captured three consecutive conference titles from 1979-81 and has finished second the past two years. Cahill's teams annually lead the SUNYAC in NCAA finishes, having placed as high as 5th in the NCAA Division III Meet in 1981. He has been twice voted SUNYAC Coach of the Year.

In 1978, Cahill became the head coach of the C-State women's swimming team in addition to his duties as the men's mentor. The Lady Dragons have dominated the New York State AIAW swimming scene each of Cahill's seasons as coach and have developed into a national powerhouse, placing 4th and 9th in the country during the past two years.

Pete and his wife, Shirley, and their children, David, and Julie, reside in Cortland.

## **Harriet R. Holsten Pool "Home of the Red Dragons"**

The Harriet R. Holsten Pool in Cortland State's impressive Park Center has been home to the Red Dragon swim teams since 1972. The pool is named in memory of the late Mrs. Holsten, a Cortland faculty member and an ardent supporter of the aquatics program at the College from 1929 until her retirement in 1972. Mrs. Holsten died in March, 1977.

An excellent facility, the Holsten Pool measures 45 feet by 50 meters and can be divided into three areas through the use of two movable bulkheads. Generally, the bulkheads are employed to allow separate areas for swimming and diving competition.

Six competitive lanes line the pool, while the diving area has a pair of one-meter boards and a pair of three-meter boards. Other features of the facility include an automatic timer scoreboard, underwater lighting, and a surface agitating system for diving competition.

The spectator gallery, with a capacity of 1,500, was constructed on a steep angle so that every viewer can see the entire pool. In addition to intercollegiate meets, the Holsten Pool is also used by local high schools, synchronized swim teams and for special exhibitions.
