The young but promising team includes: the 1965-66 State University of New York Athletic Conference individual medley champion Gary Seaman of North Bellmore, N.Y., letter winner Rich Michaels from New York City in the free-style, Tom Mayer of Schenectady, N.Y., in diving, and Pete Spier from Garden City Park in the breaststroke event.

Additions from last year's SUNYAC champion freshman team are: Don Heiss of Newark, N.Y., who captured the SUNYAC frosh breaststroke championship; Jerry Berger of Poughkeepsie in the breaststroke event; and Jack Leahy of Norwich, N.Y., in the freestyle event.
