

1975 Red Dragon Prospectus

Call it a rebuilding year as a result of 14 seniors departed through graduation, but don't hang black crepe around Lusk Field House for the indoor track season. The Red Dragons are young, it's true, but coach Joe Pierson is cautiously sizing up what he calls "plenty of good prospects." Though for different reasons, 1975 could be a repeat of the 1974 Red Dragon performance. After struggling through an injury-laden campaign, Cortland struck it rich with the title in the season-ending New York State Track and Field Association meet. Returnees from that group include pole vault All-American Paul Ksionzyk and sprint record-holder Mike Lawrie. Cortland appears to be stronger in field events, especially after pre-season high jumps of 6-6 by Monroe CC transfer Randy Jacque and 6-4 by freshman Simon Viltz. With Gary Tiffany eligible. the sprints will be even stronger and the Red Dragons appear solid in the mile relay and middle distances. In the latter areas, Tiffany joins soph Paul Kirchhoff and the tandem of twins Jerry and Perry Jenkins.

Cortland Invitational

The Cortland Invitational, annually a top attraction among New York State's top indoor teams, is shrinking in size as it grows in stature. Last year's 21-school field was an all-time high, but Cortland coach Joe Pierson expects about 15 teams to enter this season. Stiffer qualifying standards to be imposed will provide what Pierson describes as "more quality than quantity." March 1 is the date this year for the all-day affair which is used as a preparatory meet by many of the teams for conference, state and national meets.
