COACH PETE CAHILL

Pete Cahill is in his first year as a member of the teaching and coaching staff of Cortland's Department of Physical Education. A 1966 graduate of Cortland, he has a master's degree from the University of Massachusetts and is working toward a doctor's degree in physical education at Springfield College.

As an undergraduate at Cortland, Cahill was a member of the varsity swimming team for four years and captained the squad as a senior. He swam in butterfly and breast stroke competition. He also played two years of varsity tennis.

Before coming to Cortland, Cahill was a teaching fellow in tests and measurements at Springfield College. From 1969 to 1971, he was varsity swimming and tennis coach at the SUNY College at Plattsburgh. He previously taught physical education in the public schools of Clarkstown, N.Y., where he also coached tennis and wrestling. He is a native of Watertown and grew up in Malone, N.Y., graduating from Franklin Academy there.

THE 72-73 SEASON

The Red Dragon swimmers are facing the current season with only three letter winners back from last year's team which finished with a 6-6 record. Gary Kenline a junior from Kenmore, is probably the best swimmer on the squad. He was the 100 yard freestyle champion in SUNYAC last year. Martin Delaney, a freshman from Pittsford, is judged to be the most versatile performer and will see lots of action. Coach Cahill is particularly high on his ability to swim the 200 yard individual medley.

This will be the last year for swimming meets in the College's Moffett Center pool. Cortland's new HPER Center will be open in 1973-74 and one of the features will be an olympic size pool with increased seating capacity.
