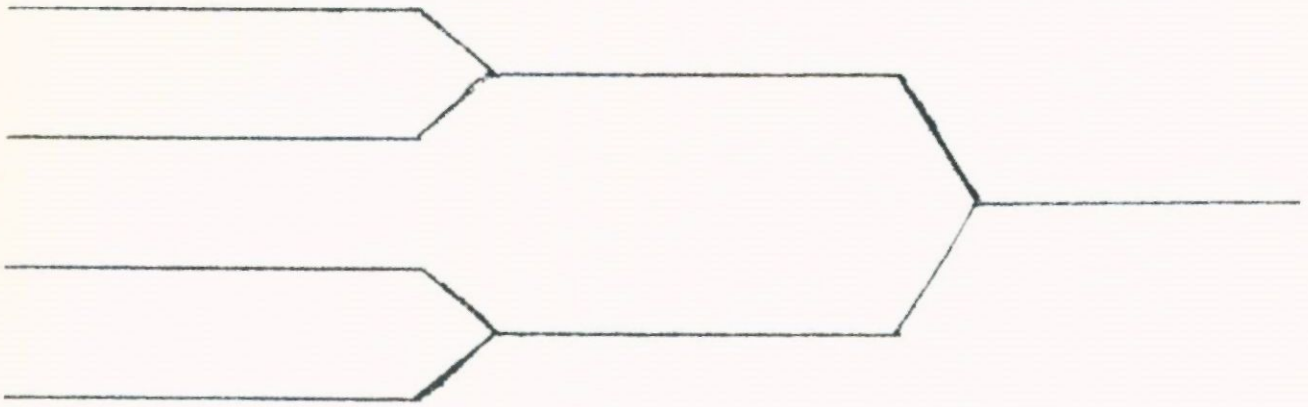
For the past 20 years, intercollegiate wrestling at Cortland has been under the direction of Coach David G. Miller. In the fall of 1969, Coach Miller announced his decision to step down from the coaching ranks to direct his full attention to his teaching duties as professor of physical education. When he retired, his coaching record at Cortland stood at 134 wins, 74 losses and 4 ties. His teams had only one losing season.

The Department of Athletics at Cortland has assigned Coach Miller's name to this Invitational Tournament "in recognition of his remarkable achievements as head wrestling coach since 1948." In making the announcement, Cortland's Director of Athletics, Francis J. Woods, said: "Dave Miller's achievements as a coach are written into the record book but perhaps his greatest contribution has been in fostering a balanced outlook between academics and athletics while working with young men at Cortland through the years. He is a true physical educator and has demonstrated his ability many times as an outstanding coach."

Coach Miller taught at Phelps and Sherburne High Schools before joining the Cortland faculty in 1948. He is an alumnus of Cortland and earned a Master of Science degree from Syracuse University. He has done doctoral work at the University of Maryland. While an undergraduate at Cortland, he played halfback in football and competed in a number of events on the track team.

In addition to coaching wrestling at Cortland, he has been involved with several other sports. He was head coach of track and field for 18 years and served as backfield and line coach for the football team. Coach Miller also guided the freshman soccer team during his early years at Cortland.

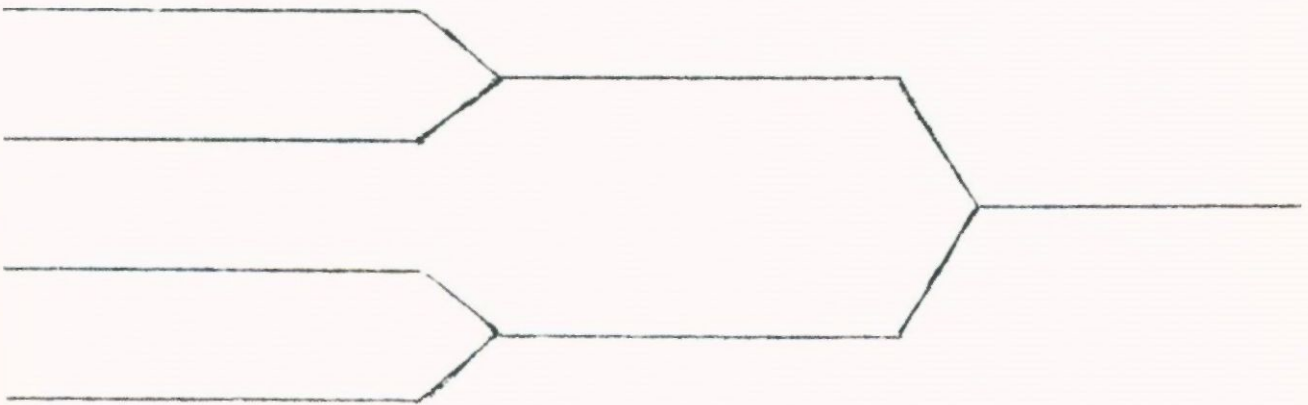
