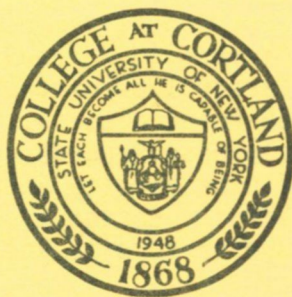

## Chuck Winters—Head Coach

Charles "Chuck" Winters has coached Cortland State's lacrosse team into post season tournaments each of the four years he has been with the Red Dragons. In 1973, his first year on "The Hill," Winters guided the Red 'n White to the USILA crown by beating Washington College in the final, 13-8. The next year, the Dragons made it to the NCAA Division II semi-finals before bowing to Hobart, 10-14. Cortland's second national lacrosse title came to the campus in 1975 as the Dragons won the NCAA crown, defeating Hobart in the championship game, 12-11. Last year, a disappointing season overall, Cortland dropped a quarter-round NCAA game to Ohio Wesleyan, 11-12.

As he begins his fifth season at Cortland, Winters' coaching record stands at 36 wins and 15 losses. His teams are averaging 13.9 goals a game while limiting opponents to 8.1 a contest. Fourteen of his players have gained All-American recognition.

Winters came to Cortland in 1971 and served two years as an assistant coach under Jack Emmer, now at Washington and Lee. Previously, he was an assistant at Bowling Green where he earned bachelor's and master's degrees. He was a second team All-American midfielder at Bowling Green during playing days and was twice named to All-Midwest squads. He played in the North-South game as a senior.

At Cortland, Winters also has coached JV soccer and has assisted with varsity football. He often is invited to participate in lacrosse clinics at the high school and college level.

## Assistant Coaches

JERRY CASCIANI--A member of the Cortland faculty since 1970, Jerry Casciani is starting his fourth season as assistant lacrosse coach. He'll be largely responsible for the team's conditioning program and will work extensively with the mid-field lines. He also has served as an assistant coach in football and has handled both varsity and JV wrestling teams. One of Casciani's previous assignments was as head lacrosse coach at Baltimore Junior College for three years. His 1967 team had an undefeated season and won the "unofficial" national junior college championship. Casciani is an alumnus of Springfield College and has a master's degree from Penn State.

BOB BUHMANN--Working with Cortland goalies and defensive lines will be Bob Buhmann who has been a member of the lacrosse staff at Cortland since 1973. A native of Levittown, he played lacrosse at Nassau Community College and at Cornell University. He was the Big Red goalie in 1971 when Cornell won the first NCAA lacrosse tournament. Buhmann recently completed a master's degree program in health education at Cortland and is now teaching at Whitney Point High School.

LARRY KING--A Cortland alumnus, Larry "Bubba" King played four years of lacrosse for the Red Dragons, playing goal and attack positions. He's coached Cortland's JV team in the past and works principally with the middies and man-up offense on the varsity. King, who is from Huntington, is working on a master's degree at Cortland.

JUD SMITH--Taking over the duties has head coach of the JV team in 1977 is Jud Smith of Massapequa. Smith, who graduated from Cortland last year, played four varsity seasons for the Red Dragons at attack and finished his career as



the all-time leading offensive player at his alma mater. He compiled 99 goals and 98 assists for a total of 197 points to surpass Rich Felser's almost insurmountable total of 175. Smith achieved second team All-American ranking as a sophomore and was accorded first team honors in his junior and senior years. He also played in the 1976 North-South game.

### **1977 Varsity Lacrosse Outlook**

Coach Chuck Winters has termed the 1977 season a "rebuilding year" but he goes on to say that this does not necessarily mean that the Red Dragons will have a bad year. Although there are only five seniors on the team, Winters believes that the Dragons' chances at their second NCAA championship are not unrealistic. Why? Because last year's Dragon squad beat Adelphi and Hobart in regular season games and both of these teams were later involved in the NCAA national championship game. And many of the 1976 Dragons are back, ready to shrug off last season's second round loss to Ohio Wesleyan in the NCAA tournament.

Attackmen Randy Glading of Lynbrook, Mike Hoppey of Setauket, and Bill Duford of Rochester are three of these returnees. Last season, Hoppey was Cortland's leading point getter with 47. He did it with 26 goals and 21 assists. Duford was number four in points with 14. He got his with four goals and ten assists. Glading is noted as a crease attacker.

Two freshmen stand to help out strongly on offense, according to Winters. They are Mark Koetzner of Massapequa and Mike Fitzpatrick of

Westbury. If they do not start at attack, they will start as middies. Sophomore attackman Rich Bucaro of Great Neck will also see considerable action.

Returning defensemen are All-Americans Dave Richardson of Rochester and Jim Burke of Bethpage. They are definite starters. Others who will receive a lot of playing time on defense will be Kerry O'Shanick of Corning, Jim Bonaventura of Dix Hills, or Paul Bridge of Longmeadow, Mass. Richardson was second in defensive saves last season with four.

Returnee Dave Haefele of Wilton, Conn., will start in the goal for the Dragons. Last season, he played in five games allowing 11 goals and chalking up 12 saves. Back-upgoalie will be Joe Lore of Elmont, a transfer student from Nassau Community College.

Pat McHugh of Watertown, Pete Fallon of Bethpage, and Bob Leyden of Levittown will be the Dragon's primary middies. They will be helped out by Larry O'Leary of Levittown, Pete Krebs of Corning, Bruce Quinby of Baldwinsville, Kevin Broderick of Setauket, and Dave Redmond of Garden City.

With these combinations and with Fallon and Burke sparking the team as co-captains, Coach Winters hopes to make the NCAA tourney by placing among the top twelve teams in the College Division. Even better would be to draw a first round bye by placing among the top eight. But there are a number of formidable teams on the schedule that Winters sees as major obstacles. All in all, it should make for a full season of exciting intercollegiate lacrosse--the 31st in the history of the sport at Cortland.
