Head Coach— Fred Taube

Fred Taube enters his third season as Cortland head coach. An associate professor in the physical education department, he is also an assistant to Joe Pierson with the indoor track team.

Currently the first vice-president of the National Soccer Coaches Association, Taube was named State University of New York Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in 1973, his first year as head coach.

Before becoming head coach, Taube coached the Cortland JV team.

A Brockport graduate, Taube has a master's degree from the University of North Carolina and a Ph.D. from the University of Utah.

Before joining the faculty at Cortland in 1970, Taube was a coach of track and soccer at MacMurray College. Prior to that, he had taught at Auburn University, where he was also coach of the soccer club.

1975 Outlook

The emphasis switches from defense this season as the Red Dragons gun for a third post-season appearance in a row. A second consecutive victory in the ECAC Upstate New York regional capped an 8-2-5 season.

That club allowed 7 goals for the best defensive record in Cortland history. However, four 0-0 ties helped keep the Dragons from an NCAA bid.

There should be plenty of offense to avoid the scoreless days this year.

Leading scorer Paul Gannon is back after an 8-goal season but he'll have more support on the front line and among the halfbacks.

Joining Gannon up front is returnee Mark Britt, a senior, junior college All-American of a year ago at Mohawk Valley CC Perry Nizzi, and junior John Cossaboon.

Junior Tim Sullivan is next in line among the forwards and sophs Tom Brewer and Tom Porrazzo are the first line subs.

The halfbacks are all back from last year's squad and all have proven ability to score. Jim Jordan, Kevin Tucker and Mickey Potter look like start-

ers with Kevin Maginn and Fred Hooper the top subs. Tucker may move to fullback against certain teams to join the trio of George Weissman, Elliot Simon and Bruce Ferguson. Also figuring in plans among backs are Bill Beebe and Millett Day who was an All-American while in junior college at Morrisville.

Incumbent Tom Wignot is now being pressed by a sophomore, Scott Manning, in goal. While Wignot is the stronger of the pair offensively, Manning has great reactions and appears to be better defensively.

Taube sees Oneonta alone as the class of the SUNYAC teams. However, he feels the Dragons of Cortland should battle with Brockport, Albany and Fredonia for the Division III honors in the conference as Oneonta has opted for Division I consideration. To be successful, more crucial victories like the 2-0 blanking of national-champion to-be Brockport will be needed by the Red Dragons.

The reason for the change was the retirement of Fred "Prof" Holloway, who had amassed the enviable record of 183 victories, 89 losses and 23 ties for a winning percentage of .649 since 1936.
