

HEAD COACH PETE CAHILL

Pete Cahill's contributions as head coach of the men's intercollegiate swim team at Cortland can be observed in the steadily improving won-lost records of the Red Dragons over the past four years. In his first year at the helm, Cortland managed just one win in 11 meets. In his second year, the Dragons improved to 5-8-1. In the last two campaigns, Dragon swimmers have been looking better and better while compiling records of 9-5 and 9-4. The upcoming season could be one of the best ever.

Cahill is a 1966 graduate of Cortland. He has a master's degree from the University of Massachusetts and is studying for a doctorate at Springfield College. He is a native of Watertown, N.Y., and grew up in Malone, N.Y., where he graduated from Franklin Academy.

Before coming to Cortland, Cahill was a member of the faculty at SUNY Plattsburgh, where he coached swimming and tennis, and was a teaching fellow at Springfield College.

While an undergraduate at Cortland, Cahill concentrated on the butterfly and breaststroke events as a member of the swimming team. He was captain in his senior year. He also played varsity tennis.

As a member of the Cortland staff, he also coaches cross country in the fall.

SWIMMING OUTLOOK

Perhaps the best men's swimming season in the past 15 years is the early forecast from the Cortland State pool where Coach Pete Cahill's squad has been practicing for the 1976-77 campaign which includes 11 dual meets. The season will climax March 3, 4 and 5 when Cortland hosts the annual SUNY Athletic Conference championship meet.

Cortland finished fourth in last year's conference meet and tallied a commendable 9-4 won-lost record, the best overall since Cahill took over the coaching duties in 1972-73. The team also broke six varsity records last year.

An early indication of possible good things to come this year was the first place finish for the Red Dragon swimmers in the Fourth Annual Harvest Relay Meet at Geneseo State, Nov. 20. In a field of 11 teams, Cortland won five of the 11 events and set a new varsity record in the 800 medley relay. The time was 7:42.621 and the swimmers were Kevin Markwardt of Ithaca, N.Y., Eric Harvey of Newark, N.Y., Mike Meyer of Lake Ronkonkoma, N.Y., and Paul Hansen of Ulster Park, N.Y. All but Meyer, a senior, are freshman members of the team.

That happy combination of new swimmers with the veterans is what's giving Cahill some optimistic moments as the season gets underway. It was a good recruiting year for the hard working Cahill who says the squad has depth as well as raw talent.

The backstroke will be one of Cortland's strongest events with five swimmers vying for starting spots including co-captain Meyer, a returning letterman. Lettermen Kevin Garrity of Voorheesville, N.Y., and Jeff McQuillan of Newburgh, N.Y., will be counted on along with two freshmen, Steve Kristeck of Johnson City, N.Y., and Jeff Maxwell of Latham, N.Y.

Distance freestyle events will be handled principally by two returnees, Jim Crofts of Lockport, N.Y., and Tim Francisco of Rome, N.Y. Freshmen Hansen and Harvey will be counted upon too.

Hansen and Harvey also will compete in the butterfly with junior letterman Bob Slater of Ithaca, N.Y., a Cortland record holder in two events, the 200 yard freestyle and as a member of the 1976 400 medley relay team. Senior letterman Craig Cornwell will team with two frosh, Markwardt and Steve McKinley of Vestal, N.Y. in sprint freestyle competition. Breastroke duties will be carried by senior co-captain Tom Tobin of Pease, N.H., and two first year swimmers, Markwardt and Larry Collins of Elmira, N.Y.

Two returning lettermen, Tom Olivo of Bedford Hills, N.Y., and Brian Payne of Horseheads, N.Y., will provide strong diving representation for the Dragons. Olivo took a 14th place in NCAA Division III finals last year.

PER CENTER POOL

Cortland swimming teams are beginning their third season in the College's impressive PER Center pool facility. The pool measures 45 feet by 50 meters and can be divided into three areas through the use of a pair of movable bulkheads. Generally, the bulkheads are used to allow areas for swimming competition, diving competition and warmups.

The pool is divided into six competitive lanes, while the diving area has two onemeter boards and two three-meter boards. Other features of the facility include an automatic timer and scoreboard, underwater lighting and a surface agitating system for diving competition.

The spectator gallery, on a steep enough angle so each person can see each swimming lane, has room for a crowd of 1,500.

In addition to intercollegiate meets, the men's and women's pool also is used by local high schools, synchronized swim groups and for special exhibitions.
