MEET THE VARSITY COACH



The highly versatile Dave Miller begins his eighteenth year on the Cortland faculty and coaching staffs. His overall record as wrestling coach at Cortland has reached 116 wins, 64 defeats and 3 ties.

A 1936 graduate of Cortland, Dave taught at Phelps Central School for six years and coached all the sports they offered. He was in the service four years and upon leaving Phelps, moved to the Sherburne School System. There he coached the football and basketball teams to league championships.

Since coming to Cortland in 1948, he has coached many sports including football, soccer, cross-country, track and field, and wrestling. He is a professor of physical education.

1966-67 OUTLOOK

With four lettermen returning from last year's fine squad and help due from promising sophomores, Coach Dave Miller looks for another successful season. His 1965-66 squad captured the SUNYAC Championship.

Seniors Doug Prato at 115 pounds and Paul Rose at 130, with junior Bill DeSario at 123, all SUNYAC champions last year, should make the lower weights real tough for Red Dragon opponents. Dave Bundy, a junior letterman, is expected to do well in the 137 pound class.

Three sophomores look like the class weights at 147, 152 and 160. Dave Sherman, sporting a fine freshman record, John Mulada, 2nd in the West Point Plebe Tournament in 1965, and Claude Shaw, 1964 New York State High School Athletic Association champion, should pick up their share of points as well.

Bill Pestell, a transfer from Auburn Community College, and Mike Tully, a sophomore should hold their own in the 167 and 177 pound classes, respectively. John Camelio, a senior, will give his competitives a tussle at 191.

Sophomore Jim Brown must carry the red and white color in the heavy weight class until senior John Longuil returns from student teaching next semester.

The squad has better balance than in recent years with at least two men battling it out for starting spots in the different weights.
