NYSAIAW Div. II Championships Cortland - 1st in 7 team field

AIAW Div. III Championships Cortland - 20th A 1966 graduate of Cortland, Pete Cahill is in his ninth season as head coach of the men's swimming team and his third season as the women's head coach. Both teams won championships last year, the men winning their second consecutive SUNYAC crown and the women capturing the NYSAIAW Division II title.

Under Coach Cahill, the men's team in eight campaigns has won 63 meets, lost 35 and tied one, a .642 winning record. Cahill has had All-American performers in five of the last six seasons.

The Red Dragon women finished 6-4 in Cahill's first year as their coach. The team improved considerably last year, registering a 7-2 mark in duals and qualifying nine swimmers and one diver for Division II Nationals. Five swimmers and a diver earned All-American status.

Cahill has a master's degree from the University of Massachusetts and a doctorate from Springfield College. He is a native of Watertown, N.Y., and grew up in Malone, N.Y., where he graduated from Franklin Academy.

Before coming to Cortland, Cahill was a member of the faculty at SUNY Plattsburgh where he coached swimming and tennis. He is highly regarded as a competitor in local tennis circles.

Cortland's diving teams come under the leader-ship of Mike Corrao for the 1980-81 season. Corrao is a graduate of East Stroudsburg State College where he competed for two years at the Division II level. Previously, Corrao participated in diving at Orange County Community College. He is a graduate of Lakeland High School in Yorktown Heights, N.Y., and has earlier coaching experience at the YMCA and AAU age group level.

Corrao is presently enrolled at Cortland in the graduate program for physical education and is specializing in executive fitness. He also serves as advisor for the Racquetball Club.

MEN'S SWIMMING OUTLOOK 1980-81

The men's swimming team at Cortland State is seeking its third consecutive SUNYAC crown this season, but first will have to fill key spots left by Eric Harvey, Kevin Markwardt, and nine time All-American Jeff Maxwell, all lost to graduation.

Two time All-American senior Ed Walrath is expected to be a team leader and should do well in the backstroke and I.M. events. He will be aided by sophomore Jim Lalonde, SUNYAC champ in the 100 backstroke and 200 butterfly, and a host of others.

The butterfly event is expected to be a strong point for Cortland and Lalonde will lead the way. In contention for "fly" spots are sophomores Jan Michell, Dan Dakus, and Rob Rogan, frosh

Pete Peguero and junior Bruce Gardner. Senior Eric Waldbauer, varsity record holder in the 200 breaststroke, returns to lead the team in that event. Helping him along the way will be junior Bill Wilson.

Cortland's sprint contingent is both strong and deep. Two time state champ junior Steve Hoff is Cortland's leading sprinter and is backed by soph Andy Eicholzer and freshman Glenn Moore. Middle distances will be handled by junior Jim Swartz and Michell while the distance duties belong to soph Bob Kalin, freshmen Jeff Hopkins and Gary Mosehauer, and senior Mark Klier.

Cortland's divers should be major contenders for SUNYAC laurels with junior Scott Craighton and senior Tom Quinn returning. Soph Mark Celecki and frosh Jeff Holden could be surprises for the Dragons this year.

The relay teams should be exceptionally strong and Coach Cahill has high aspirations for national qualifiers is post-season competition.

WOMEN'S SWIMMING OUTLOOK 1980-81

The Cortland women's swim team is looking to repeat as NYSAIAW champions but must do so minus the efforts of Brenda Hickey, a 1980 graduation casualty. Many new faces are evident this year with 15 freshmen and 10 sophomores holding a majority of spots. Seniors Kathy Klier, Beth Leonard and Karen Toper, plus sophomore Joni Neuendorf, all record holders, will be mainstays for the squad.

Klier, 200 backstroke record holder, is the leading backstroker on the team. Frosh Lisa

Swart and junior Anne McNeil should add needed strength.

Neuendorf, record holder in the 100 free, 100 I.M. and 200 I.M., is the incumbent in the I.M. and will be active in freestyle events. Depth in the I.M. will be added by junior Renee Beckley, senior Cathleen O'Connor and soph Mary Homkey.

Toper holds team marks in the 50 breast, 100 breast, and 200 breast, and will again lead breaststroke efforts along with frosh Caroline Foley and Colleen Maurin. Freshmen Liz Young and Cathy Fitzpatrick are expected to take over butterfly spots in place of the departed Hickey who holds records in the 100 and 200 fly.

Neuendorf and Leonard, freestyle record holders, will handle the freestyle races and will be backed by frosh Jackie Fee, Denise Dufresne, Marcia Latulipe, and junior Terri Wallace.

The team's deepest event may be diving with sophs Diane Bianco and Karen Connolly returning. First year divers include sophs Sue Bradley and Marlene Elliott, and frosh Eileen Collins and Lori Lawler.
