

#### COACHING STAFF

VINCE GONINO

Head Coach

An assistant professor of physical education and head wrestling coach at Cortland State, Vince Gonino returns to his coaching duties after spending a sabbatical leave in 1971-72 pursuing a doctoral degree at his alma mater, Ohio State University. He expects to receive the degree this year.

In his first season as varsity coach in 69-70, Gonino led the Cortland wrestling team to a 9-3-1 dual mark and a surprise SUNY Athletic Conference championship. For his efforts, he was named second runner-up nationally for the "Rookie Coach of the Year Award" as selected by the Amateur Wrestling News.

In his two years as head varsity coach, he has a 21-5-1 record and has developed seven conference champion wrestlers and six runner-ups. In 70-71 his team won Cortland's David Miller Invitational Tournament and the Springfield College Tournament and finished second in the SUNYAC meet.

Before being named varsity coach, Gonino coached freshman grapplers at Cortland for four years. His teams compiled an impressive 30-10-1 record.

A native of Watertown, N.Y., he is a former New York State Section Three and New York YMCA wrestling champion. At Ohio State, where he received his bachelor's and master's degrees, Gonino won two AAU Championships and two Big Ten Awards in a three year varsity career with the Buckeyes.

Prior to joining the Cortland faculty he was head wrestling coach at Whitehall High School in Ohio. He later became head coach at Keystone Junior College in Pennsylvania.

While he was studying for his Ph.D. last year, Gonino served as assistant wrestling coach for the Buckeyes. He also received the Ohio State Alumni Award for his teaching and coaching contributions to the University.

In addition to his wrestling and teaching duties, Gonino is line coach for JV football team. With his wife, Jean, they own and operate Greek Peak Summer Camp which offers a day camp for boys and girls 4-12 years old and two specialized camps for junior and senior high boys in football and wrestling.

JERRY CASCIANI

Assistant Coach

A member of the Cortland faculty since 1970, Jerry Casciani is an instructor in the Men's Physical Education Department. He was head wrestling coach in 1971-72 while Vince Gonino was on sabbatical leave. Casciani guided the wrestlers to an 8-6 dual meet record. The Red Dragons finished secong in their own Miller Invitational Tournament and were third in SUNYAC.

Casciani earned a B.S. degree in physical education at Springfield College and has a master's degree from Penn State. He has coached football and wrestling at the high school and junior college level and also has coaching experience in lacrosse. Before coming to Cortland, Casciani was district chairman of health and physical education of the Northeastern School District of York County, Pa. In addition to his teaching and wrestling duties at Cortland, he serves as a defensive coach in football.

#### WRESTLING OUTLOOK

When Dave Miller retired as head wrestling coach in 1969, he stepped down with only one losing season in 20 years at Cortland. His overall record was 134 wins, 74 losses and 4 ties.

Vince Gonino and Jerry Casciani have kept the winning tradition flourishing in the last three seasons. Gonino had records of 10-3-1 and 12-2 in his first two years as head coach. Casciani took over last year while Gonino was pursuing a doctor's degree and guided the Red Dragons to an 8-6 mark. So it's been only one losing season in 23 years of intercollegiate wrestling at Cortland.

Cortland's schedule is one of the most competitive ever. The season opens at home with the Miller Invitational Tournament as the Dragons host SUNY Binghamton, Cornell and Lycoming. In addition to the traditional dual meets, Cortland is entered in the Springfield College Meet with Springfield, Dartmouth and Union, and the York College Tournament with Frostburg State, Virginia Commonwealth and York. Morgan State is a new opponent on the Dragons schedule and will visit Cortland in a triangular meet with Oswego.

Five lettermen are back from last year's team. Five others who won participation awards also are on the roster. The man who will be missed the most is heavyweight Len Schlacter who graduated after gaining All-American honors and a fourth place finish in NCAA College Division competition.

Two newcomers, freshmen Dean Brown of South Dayton and Pat Hickey of Hicksville are likely starters in the 118 pound class. Carrying the Red 'n White in the 126 pound class will be senior Paul Thompson of Freeport and freshman Henry Kwiatkowski of Owego.

Two of the lettermen back will be wrestling in the 134 weight class, junior Larry Bryant of West Seneca and senior Dom Scolaro of Binghamton. Last year, Bryant was 2-3 and Scolaro was 4-4.

The team's senior co-captains will be meeting the opposition in the next two weight categories. In the 142 class will be Jim Lomonaco of Binghamton and in the 150 class will be Bob DaRin of East Syracuse. Lomonaco was injured last year and saw little action. DaRin had a very successful 9-2 record and a third place finish in the SUNYAC tournament.

Junior Joe Bernholz of Valley Stream and sophomore Phil Kenul of Plainview have been doing battle for the starting spot at 158 and both have impressed. Kenul was 2-3 last season and gained a second place finish in SUNYAC.

Senior Tom Roche of Bellmore looks like the starter at 167 pounds. He won 2 and lost 2 last season. In the 177 pound class, senior Vince Ruggiero of Manhasset and junior Jim Stine of Schuylerville will be seeing most of the action. Ruggiero was the tough middle guard for Cortland's football team.

Junior Scott Guild of Auburn will wrestle in the 190 pound class. A letterman, he was 4-7 a year ago and earned third place in SUNYAC. Senior Russ Hohlman of South Hempstead will get the call in the unlimited division. Also a footballer, he played defensive tackle for the Dragons.
