COACHING STAFF

VINCE GONINO

Head Coach

Varsity wrestling at Cortland State has been under the guidance of head coach Vince Gonino since 1969. In his first season, he led the Red Dragons wrestlers to a 9-3-1 dual mark and a SUNY Athletic Conference championship. For his efforts, he was named runner up nationally for the "Rookie Coach of the Year Award" as selected by the Amateur Wrestling News.

In four years of varsity coaching, Gonino's teams have won 34, lost 22 and tied 1. He did not coach in 1971-72 while he was completing work on his doctor's degree at Ohio State.

Before being named varsity coach, Gonino coached the J.V. team at Cortland for four years. His squads compiled an impressive 30-10-1 record. He has also been head coach at Keystone Junior College and Whitehall (Ohio) High School.

TOM BUTCHER

A native of South Dayton, N.Y., Tom Butcher was a standout football player and wrestler until his 1970 graduation. The former 177- and 190-pounder is now a graduate assistant at Cortland working on his Master's degree. Since graduation, Butcher has coached wrestling and football in Auburn.

OUTLOOK

Of Cortland's 40-man roster, only 17 wrestlers remain from last season. Yet coach Vince Gonino is confident he has a much stronger outfit than the club which went 5-10 in dual meets and sixth in the SUNYAC tournament.

The key to the team's hopes is the fact that there are experienced competitors at all but two weight classes—126 and heavyweight—and with some classes two and three deep in experience.

It wasn't a mass graduation that decimated the ranks, but rather a mass transfer—a transfer in.

An example of the transfers is 158-pounder Rory Whipple, who placed fifth in the junior college nationals last year while toiling for Farmingdale. Another is 150-pounder Lou Rosati, who steps into a regular role after two years at Morrisville.

Even though transfers have been in the thick of the competition at many weight classes, returnees bring much experience. Ken Doi is back at 118, Rick Bailey at 134, Phil Kenul up a class at 167, Ed Bulgin at 177 and Bill Hedges down a class at 190. Joe Rotella will attempt to bounce back from an injury-marred year at 142.

Among the promising newcomers is freshman Jim Fruscella, who will battle both Kenul and soph John Libby at 167.
