Vince Gonino

Vince Gonino is beginning his sixth season as Cortland's varsity wrestling coach. In that time, Gonino's teams have compiled a 38-30-1 record.

Gonino took over the head wrestling post in 1969 and led Cortland to a 9-3-1 dual meet record and the State University of New York Athletic Conference championship. He was named runner-up in the voting by the Amateur Wrestling News for "Rookie Coach of the Year Award."

Before taking over the varsity job, Gonino coached the Cortland junior varsity, compiling a 30-10-1 record over four seasons.

Gonino is a graduate of the Ohio State University, where he also earned an M.S. and PhD.

Kevin Spencer

A 1975 graduate of Springfield College, Kevin Spencer is a graduate assistant this year at Cortland and is handling the JV wrestling team.

A native of Monroe, N.Y., Spencer was a lacrosse captain and Most Valuable Player while at Springfield and also played football. He will also assist with the Red Dragon lacrosse team.

1975-76 Outlook

118--Freshman Tim Booker is a New York State freestyle and Greco-Roman champion as well as a two-time Section VI champ in high school. He'll be in a battle with returnee Mo Robinson and frosh John Gagliardi.

126--John Ciotoli, another freshman, won the state title last season and is a two-time Section IV champ. His major challenges are from frosh Mike Lange and junior Kim Lathers.

134--Junior Rick Bailey returns but should be pushed by former state runnerup and local product Dick Meldrim. In the picture as well is frosh Pete Rossi, the Section IV No. 2 man and Mike Nelson, titlist in Section II last year.

142--Don Cooper was a place winner in the junior college regionals while at Auburn Community College last year and looks strong. Another transfer is Joe Pennacchio, in from Farmingdale: John Bautochka, last year's 118-pounder, has added some weight and should be strong along with freshman Chris Bourne, a Section V winner. Lou Rosati, fourth last season in the SUNYAC championships may enter the picture as soon as Rory Whipple is ready at 150.

150--Whipple was Cortland's top wrestler a year ago, taking the SUNYAC title at 158, then the runnerup spot in the state meet. He should be slow in starting due to a knee operation in the off-season.

158--Whipple moved down to 150 to make room for Rick Armstrong, a former New York high school champion. Also strong in this class is freshman Tom Ciavarri from Rochester.

167--John Libby is the incumbent, but state place winner Cliff Moore will challenge for the top spot. Moore is a freshman, Libby a senior.

177--Junior Bill Hedges is the top man right now, but he will be pushed by Kevin Lewis, a transfer recovering from a minor knee operation.

190--Dan Boyd should move back into his regular spot as soon as he catches up from the football season. Also in the picture is soph Dale Hulett as well as junior Tim Clifford.

Unlimited--Herschel Gornbein is up to 6-foot-5 and 300 pounds and is far more aggressive than last season. Junior Bill Rasbeck, another football player, lends more experience to the weight class.
