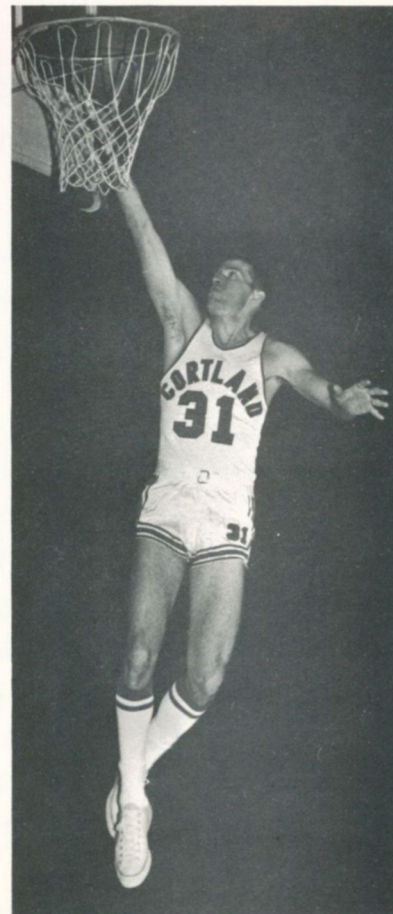

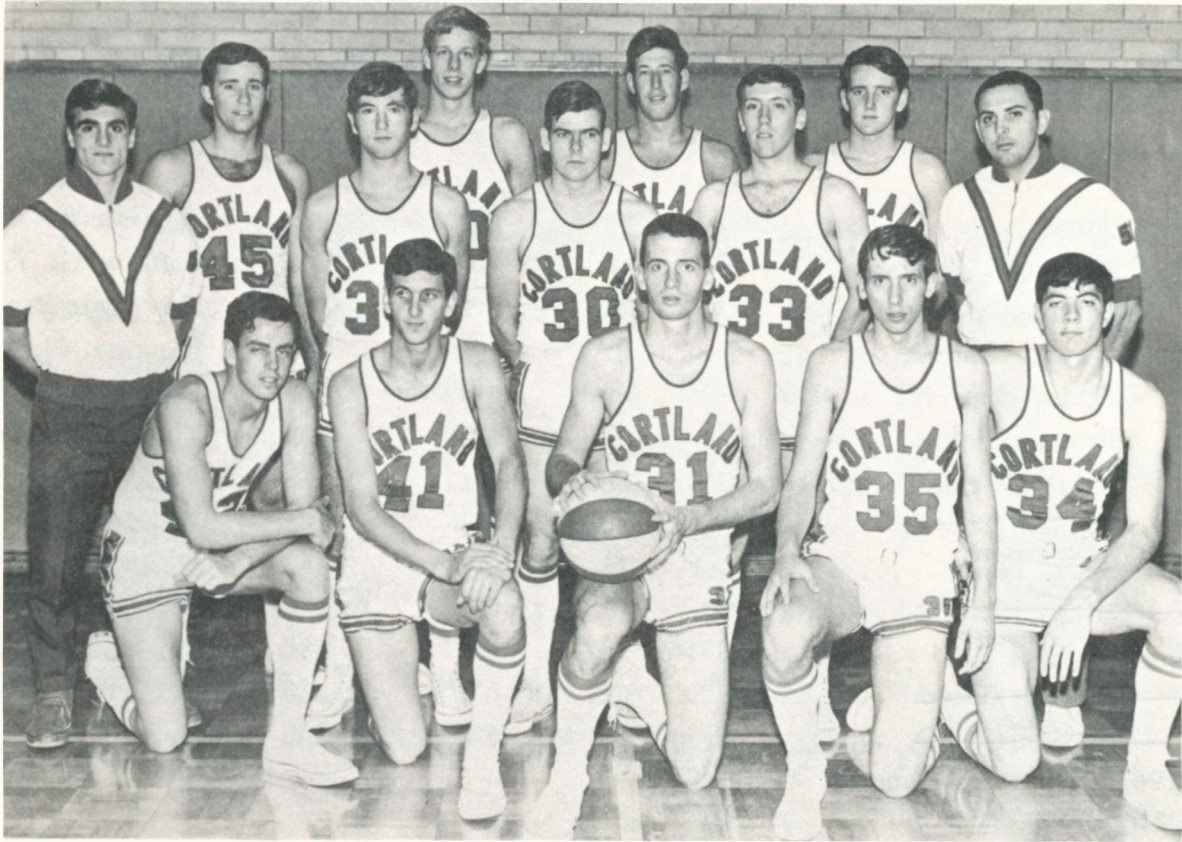

Tonight's SUNYAC Conference game between Cortland and Brockport is important in determining Cortland's chances for success in the Conference. Cortland is unbeaten in conference play with a 2-0 record and is 4-6 in overall play. Brockport is 3-2 in the Conference and 7-5 on the season.

Sophomores Mike Eidel and Earl Rogers and seniors Bob Chrust and Bill Williams led the way for Cortland in their last game, a 66-54 win over Oswego. Eidel and Williams provided the scoring punch while Chrust and Rogers took care of the rebounding and defense.

Eidel, working from his guard slot, was the game's top scorer with 20 points. His 14 point burst in the first half was primarily responsible for the Dragon's 33-20 halftime lead. Williams chipped in with 15 points, 10 of them coming in the big first half.

Chrust and Rogers dominated the backboards to give Cortland a 54-37 margin in the rebounding department. Chrust, one of the nation's leading rebounders with an average of 17.4, grabbed 22, while Rogers had his best night of the season on the boards with 15. Both Chrust and Rogers were tough defensively, blocking numerous shots and closing the middle to Oswego.

Coach Al Stockholm was pleased with the defensive work of his team, particularly Rogers, Chrust and 6-6 Bob Alspaugh. Alspaugh turned in an impressive performance playing in his first game since being sidelined January 11 with an ankle injury.

Brockport is led by guard Jim Scott, averaging 15.7 points per game, and two good forwards, 6-2 Zac Angelowicz (13.3) and 6-3 Tom Marschner (10.6).
