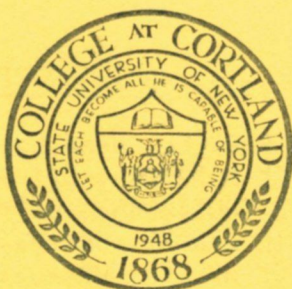

He caught 5 passes for 158 yards surpassing the old mark of 152 set in 1970 by Earl Rogers, now an assistant coach at Cortland.
