Abstract: Drawing upon five years of ethnographic research with over 100 Denver, Colorado women involved in street-based sex work and drug use, this paper explores what the women's discursive framings of men who facilitate women's sex work activities reveal about the exclusionary social and criminal justice practices that shape their lives.

Resumen: Este trabajo recurre a cinco años de investigación etnográfica con más de cien mujeres de Denver, Colorado involucradas en el trabajo sexual y el consumo de drogas. Explora los marcos discursivos utilizados por las mujeres al describir a los hombres quienes fomentan el trabajo sexual de mujeres y lo que se nos revelan de las prácticas exclusionistas del sistema social y jurídico el cual determina la vida de ellas.

Resumo: Baseado em cinco anos de pesquisa etnográfica em Denver Colorado com 100 mulheres envolvidas na venda de sexo e no consumo de drogas no contexto da rua, o presente artigo explora as aproximações discursivas dessas mulheres para com os homens que facilitam as atividades de trabalho sexual e o que esses discursos revelam sobre as práticas excludentes da sociedade e do sistema de justiça que moldam as vidas dessas mulheres.
